## Overview

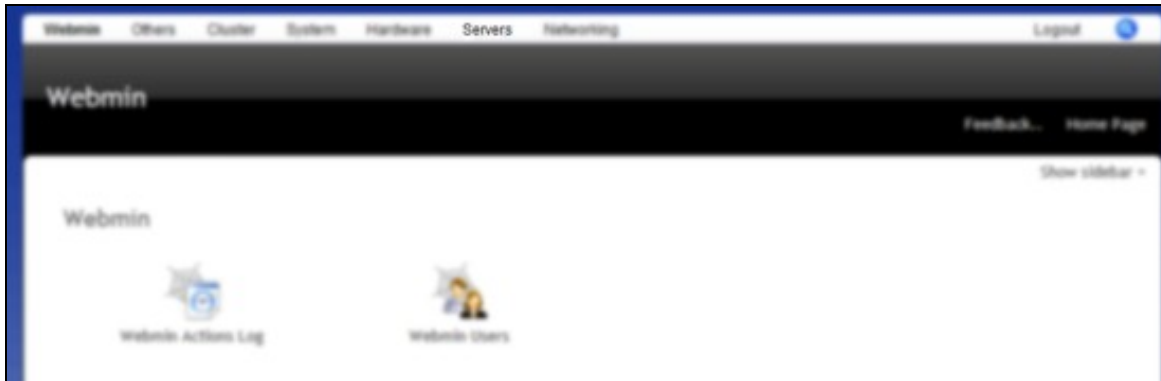
This article describes the process of creating a Read Only MySQL user on High Availability PINsafe appliances.

## Prerequisites

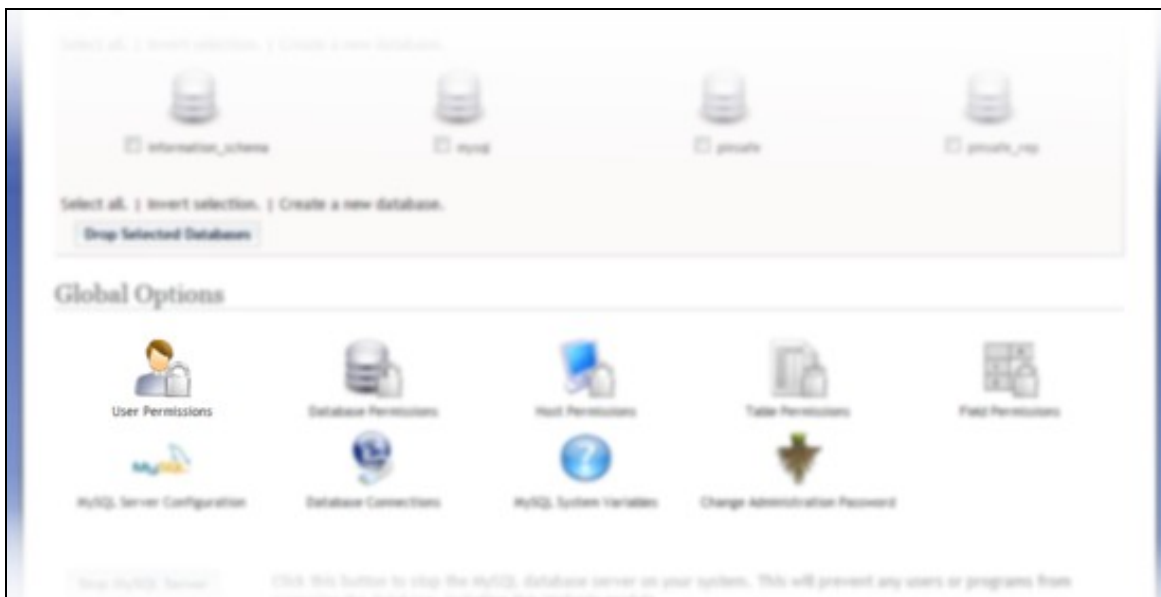
- High Availability Active/Active appliances
- MySQL as the configured database

## Solution

- Login to Webmin on the appliance you intend to query (see [Webmin How To Guide](#) if you are unfamiliar with this);
- Select the Servers -> MySQL Database Server menu option;



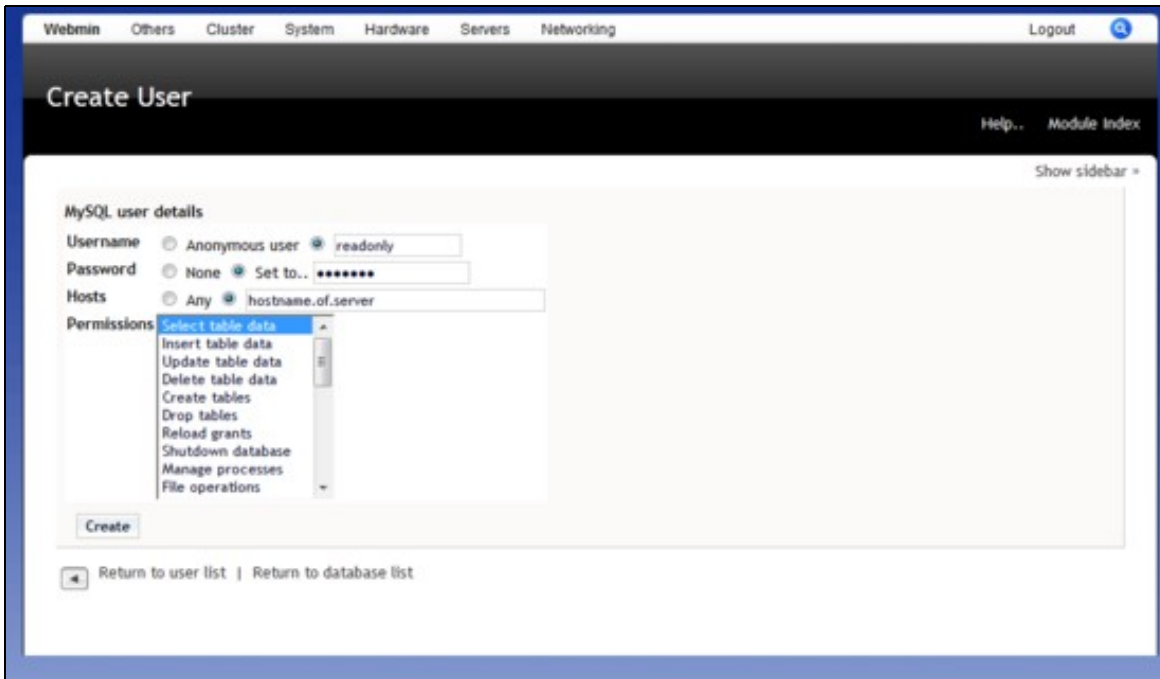
- Click the "User Permissions" icon;



- Click the "Create new user" link towards the top of the page.



You should then be able to create a new user and provide it with "Select" privileges from the list as a minimum, to provide Read Only access.
